Is the service part of the local authority?

- We are partially commissioned to Destiny Support which is a voluntary organisation based in Slough. This means that we are supported by the LA but we work at an arms length for the local authority.

- The service is confidential and we only contact other LA officers or professionals with parents' and carers' permission

Slough parent partnership service can help by:

- Providing parents and carers with impartial support, information and practical help, especially those with children who have or may have special educational needs
- Accompanying you to meetings held at school or with LA officers, health professionals or social workers, taking notes for you if required.
- Putting you in touch with parent support groups and specialist support agencies, voluntary and statutory agencies
- Making sure your views and those of your child are heard
- Providing information and support in a range of languages and formats as needed
- Informing you of local and regional procedures for resolving disagreement at an early stage

What does the service offer?

- A trained parental supporter from within the service or from another organisation
- A telephone helpline
- Visits at a time and place suitable to you, including your home
- Links with a variety of services and organisations, both statutory and voluntary
- It promotes partnership and involvement between yourselves and the LA, schools and other agencies in your child's education
- It promotes parent and carer perspective within schools and the LA, for example through the Parents' SEN and Disabled Children Forum and working parties
